## **Seeking clarity in diversity**

### **Exploring cognitive heterogeneity in schizophrenia-spectrum disorders**

1. Cognitive impairment is not a core feature of all patients with schizophrenia-spectrum disorders. (dit proefschrift)
2. Heterogeneity is a major challenge, not only in schizophrenia-spectrum disorders but in the general field of psychiatry. (dit proefschrift)
3. Studying subgroups with shared illness characteristics improves the understanding of schizophrenia-spectrum disorders more than the commonly used case-control designs. (dit proefschrift)
4. While standardized neurocognitive test settings provide experimental control, they lack sensitivity in measuring the impact of cognitive impairment on daily life. (dit proefschrift)
5. Selection bias of study participants is a critical issue in psychiatric research and limits the level of generalizability to wider populations. (dit proefschrift)
