Curriculum vitae

Mária Šlěšková was born on 22nd May, 1979 in Trstená, Slovakia. She attended the Ľudovít Štúr Grammar school in Trenčín, and then continued her studies at Trnava University. She graduated in psychology in 2002 with a thesis in social psychology dealing with 'Concept of home among adolescents'. After graduation she worked for a few months as a school psychologist at the elementary school in Melčice-Lieskové. At the end of 2002 she became an employee of the Institute of Social Sciences, Faculty of Science, PJ Safarik University in Košice where she still works as a researcher. Her research interest focuses on psycho-social determinants of adolescents' health and risk behaviour.
