**CURRICULUM VITAE**

José Paulo Simão Henriques was born on March 16th 1966 in Amsterdam. Secondary school was the Hervormd Lyceum Zuid in Amsterdam (1978-1984). He studied medicine at the University of Amsterdam and graduated in 1992. For a total of 9 months he worked at the department of Physiology of the Medical Faculty of the University of Lisbon. After graduation from medical school he was a House Officer in England during 6 months. After returning to The Netherlands, he was a resident of cardiothoracic surgery at the O.L.V.G Hospital in Amsterdam and at the Antonius Hospital in Nieuwegein. In 1996 he started his residency in cardiology at the Sophia Hospital in Zwolle and started his cardiology training in 1997. Internal Medicine residencies were at the Sophia Hospital (dr. M van Marwijk Kooij) and at the Weezenlanden Hospital (dr. G. Kolsters and dr. J. G. van der Star). In 1999 he was a cardiology trainee resident at the Sophia Hospital (H. A. Oude Luttikhuis).
